Summary of the actions taken at the City Council meeting

CITY CLERK

Resolution No. 003-2025

Adopted resolution approving a General Services Agreement (GSA) with the County of Los Angeles. The City's current GSA with the County of Los Angeles will expire on June 30, 2025. To ensure the continuity of essential County services currently provided to the City of Hawaiian Gardens and to expand these offerings in the future, the city renewed the GSA for an additional five years, from July 1, 2025, to June 30, 2030. The services covered under the GSA include "as-needed" time-limited services such as animal control, the prosecution of city ordinances, direct assessment collection, and various public works services.

Public Safety Commission Appointment

Roselia (Rosi) Gomez was appointed to the Public Safety Commission to fill an unexpired term ending in March 2026.

PUBLIC WORKS

Resolution No. 002-2025

Adopted resolution approving the City of Hawaiian Gardens 2025 updated 5-year Pavement Management Program (PMP). The PMP is an essential tool in determining the condition, expected life, recommended improvements, and associated costs of the City's pavement assets. The program enables the City to prioritize pavement rehabilitation projects where they are most cost effective.
