Summary of the actions taken at the City Council meeting

CITY MANAGER

City Attorney Contract

Approved an amendment to our Legal Services agreement with Best Best & Krieger (BBK) appointing Norma Tabares of BBK to Serve as City Attorney.

Resolution No. 007-2025

Adopted resolution amending our Sister City Travel and Donation Policy. The policy updates reflect rising costs/expenses, clarifying donation requests, amounts, disbursement, and expectations.

PUBLIC WORKS

Resolution No. 006-2025

Adopted resolution identifying the Street Improvement Projects and adopting the list of Projects for Fiscal Year 2025-2026 funded by SB-1: SB-1 provides additional state funding to address basic road maintenance, rehabilitation, and critical safety needs on highways and local streets, which is funded by a per gallon fuel tax and vehicle registration fees.

Approved a \$1,500 donation to Artesia High School, to support an annual "I'm Going to College" event celebrating the achievement of graduating seniors who are embarking on their college journeys.
