Summary of the actions taken at the City Council meeting

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

Resolution No. 012-2025

Adopted resolution approving an Amended and Restated Joint Exercise of Powers Authority Agreement. The Gateway Water Management Authority was established in 2007 by a Joint Powers Authority Agreement (“JPA”). The agency was formed to address the state’s efforts that encouraged and prioritized regional, multi-party, and/or multi-benefit projects for competitive funding. Because GWMA’s membership and responsibilities have grown and evolved since its inception, the JPA Agreement is now being amended to best reflect current and anticipated activities, roles, and responsibilities.

FINANCE

Matrix Consulting Group Contract

Approved an agreement with Matrix Consulting Group to provide consulting services to update the City Fee Schedules and prepare a development impact fee study.

Adopted resolution adopting a two-year budget for the fiscal years of 2025-2026 and 2026-2027

PUBLIC WORKS

Completion of Carson Street Beautification Phase II, Project 108

Accept the construction improvements by Hardy & Harper, Inc., for the Carson Street Beautification Phase II, Project 108, as complete. Which included a comprehensive range of infrastructure and aesthetic upgrades along Carson Street, between Norwalk Boulevard and Bloomfield Avenue.

PUBLIC SAFETY

Resolution No. 010-2025

Adopted resolution authorizing an amendment to the agreement for reimbursement for helicopter patrol services by and between the City of Hawaiian Gardens and the City of Lakewood – Sky Knight Program.

CITY MANAGER

VFW Post 7243 Donation

Approved a \$5,000 donation to the Hawaiian Gardens VFW Post 7243, to assist with the cost of their renovations for critical upgrades that include structural repairs, accessibility enhancements, and much-needed updates to their restrooms, flooring, and gathering areas.
