## Summary of the actions taken at the City Council meeting

### CITY ATTORNEY

#### Retirement Incentive Program

Disclosed the costs of providing benefits under a voluntary early retirement incentive program.

### PUBLIC WORKS

#### Monthly Reports Received and Filed

Permits Report for the month of June 2025.

#### Elecnor Belco Electric Contract

Award a construction contract in the amount of \$303,313 for the Norwalk Boulevard Pedestrian Safety Improvements, Project 117. The proposed project includes the installation of a High-Intensity Activated Crosswalk (HAWK) signal at Norwalk Boulevard and 216th Street.

#### Citywide Tree Maintenance Services

Award an agreement with West Coast Arborists, Inc., for the provision of citywide tree maintenance services for a term of three years.

#### Transtech Engineers Contract

Approved a fifth amendment to the professional services agreement to add project management services for the installation and configuration of new permitting software in Community Development.

### PUBLIC SAFETY

#### Traffic Study near Melbourne Elementary

Requested staff to create a speed hump policy and to pursue a Traffic Study on Claretta Avenue, between Carson Street and Centralia Street. This request came from the Public Safety Commission because of their concern about reckless driving and speeding near Melbourne Elementary School.

#### Immigration-Related Resources

Staff was requested to create a plan of action; and prepare a comprehensive resource guide for residents to know their rights, know which local organizations offer support, and steps to be prepared.

### FINANCE

#### Resolution No. 021-2025

Adopted resolution approving the 2025-2026 Community Development Block Grant Program and Budget. The CDBG projects that are being proposed are Street Improvements and Neighborhood Clean-Up.

#### SDI Presence Agreement

Approved an agreement with SDI Presence LLC for consulting services for the procurement and implementation of a new Enterprise Resource Planning System.

#### Reports Received and Filed

Receive and file warrants processed during the period of June 28 to July 11, 2025.

### HUMAN RESOURCES

#### Resolution No. 022-2025

Modified the effective date of the Salary Schedule approved by Resolution No. 004-2025, and adopted a revised Salary Schedule for employees within the AFSCME Rank and File Unit, to implement a 2.5% increase effective July 1, 2025
