Summary of the actions taken at the City Council meeting

PUBLIC WORKS

Traffic Study on Claretta

Staff was directed to conduct a traffic study on Claretta for the installation of a speed hump or other traffic calming measures for the vicinity of Melbourne Elementary.

Resolution No. 023-2025

Adopted a resolution approving the Citywide Bicycle Master Plan. The plan outlines prioritization criteria and identifies key projects to guide implementation efforts. Serving as a strategic roadmap for enhancing the City's pedestrian and bicycle infrastructure, the plan can also support the City in securing grant funding for future street improvements.

Resolution No. 024-2025

Adopted a resolution approving a change order for the City Hall Roof Replacement, Project 118. The change order will cover the re-roofing of approximately 11,000 square feet at the C. Robert Lee Activity Center Building.

Resolution No. 026-2025

Adopted a resolution approving the 2025 Sewer System Management Plan (SSMP) Update. The SSMP was prepared with the intent to provide a plan to properly manage, operate, and maintain all parts of the City's sanitary sewer system and to help reduce and prevent emergency spills, as well as mitigate any sewage spills that do occur.

FINANCE

Reports Received and Filed

Receive and file warrants processed during the period of July 12 to August 1, 2025.

Received and filed the Treasurer's Report for the month of June 2025.

Donations to Non-Profits

Approved a \$5,000 donation to Hawaiian Gardens Eagles Soccer Club for team uniforms, equipment and league/tournament registrations; and a \$5,000 donation to Hawaiian Gardens Little League for the youth baseball and softball programs, opening and closing ceremonies.

CITY ATTORNEY

Retirement Incentive Program

Approved a retirement incentive program to permit eligible employees to elect to retire sooner than they would have otherwise retired in exchange for an incentive benefit of \$25,000. The program was amended to extend the election window from October 10, 2025, to October 31, 2025; and the retirement effective date to be no later than November 5, 2025.

CITY MANAGER

Resolution No. 025-2025

Adopted a resolution approving the salary ranges and benefits for unrepresented at-will confidential and non-confidential professional and management positions.

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
