Summary of the actions taken at the City Council meeting

PUBLIC WORKS

Monthly Report Received and Filed

Permits Report for the month of August 2025.

Gateway Cities Regional Fiber Optic Network

Approved a Right-of-Way Use Agreement between the City and the Gateway Cities Council of Governments will allow the City to utilize the Network by granting GCCOG access to and encroachment of the City's rights-of-way in perpetuity for the purpose of installing, operating, and maintaining the Network. In an effort to satisfy this unserved need, local governments have actively analyzed the benefits of investing in fiber network infrastructure to facilitate broadband service.

Gateway Water Management Authority

Approved a third amendment to the MOU for the Gateway Water Management Authority. Extending the agreement for 5 years for the administration and cost sharing to prepare a Watershed Management Plan and Coordinated Integrated Monitoring Program for the Lower San Gabriel River Watershed.

CITY ATTORNEY

Opioid Distributors

Opted into a settlement agreement with Purdue Pharma, L.P. and Sackler Family. The City opted into this new settlement, thereby releasing its claims against Purdue, in order to receive a maximum of **\$15,400** paid out over a period of fifteen (15) years. The funds are restricted to certain opioid abatement/remediation uses.

Opted into a settlement agreement with Alvogen Inc., Amneal Pharmaceuticals, Inc., Apotex Corp., Hikama Pharmaceuticals USA, Inc., Indivior, Inc., Mylan, Sun Pharmaceuticals Industries, Inc. and Zydus Pharmaceuticals (USA) Inc. The City opted into this new settlement, thereby releasing its claims against the Settling Parties, in order to receive a maximum of **\$2,450**, paid out over a period of ten (10) years. The funds are restricted to certain opioid abatement/remediation uses.

City Manager Employment Agreement

Approve Amendment No. 2 to the City Manager Employment Agreement, extending the term through June 30, 2029.
